JAMES CONNOLLY VISITOR CENTRE

Áras Uí Chonghaile is a visitor centre dedicated to telling the story of James Connolly. The visitor exhibition tells the story of his life, from his birth in Edinburgh, to travelling across the United States and his involvement in the 1916 Easter Rising leading to his subsequent death.

TAXITRAX

Taxitrax is the Largest and Original and most authentic taxi tour in Belfast. Experienced guides will take you through sites of historical and political interest, explaining the significance of the Belfast murals and telling the story of the recent conflict sharing personal accounts and experiences.

CLONARD MONASTERY

Clonard Monastery is a Catholic church and monastery, home to the Redemptorists religious order and host of the annual Clonard Solemn Novena. Fr Alec Reid hosted crucial discussions between John Hume (SDLP) and Gerry Adams (Sinn Fein) to begin a dialogue on a peaceful way forward out of the conflict.

MILLTOWN CEMETERY

Opened in 1869, Milltown is a large cemetery located in the heart of west Belfast. Over 200,000 people are buried here including Cathal O Byrne, Albert Sharpe and is also the resting place for Irish Republicans Bobby Sands, Tom Williams, Mairead Farrell and Winifred Carney.


